


Types of funding: Equity, loans, grants

Biotechnology Investor / Innovation Incentive Tax Credit

**Tax Credits:** Refunds ≥33% of private investor's investment in qualified MD biotech company to investor

Manufacturing/Job Creation Tax Credits

**Tax Credits:** Tax incentives tied to manufacturing jobs, other job creation, funds job training.
