From October 2017 to May 2022, Mr. Gillenwater served concurrently as a senior director with a trio of collaborating Maryland and Hong Kong charities: the National Foundation for Cancer Research, Asian Fund for Cancer Research and AIM-HI Accelerator Fund. While through to October 2017, he was Maryland Commerce's longtime Asia regional manager with the Office of International Investment and Trade and, temporarily, its acting director.
